would be what i would be considered to

00:45

be a basic suit so

00:47

a charcoal gray is a neutral color so

00:50

it's very easy

00:51

to match up really any color with it

it's going to look nice

and with custom suits you get to choose

00:57

the lining and the buttons and the

threads so

01:00

as you can see with this charcoal gray

01:02

suit i did a brown button with some

01:04

brown thread

01:06

and obviously it's going to look great

01:07

with a white shirt

01:10

but again with a gray suit you can mix

01:12

and match

01:13

with many different colors because again

01:15

gray is a neutral color so really any

01:17

color is going to look good with it

01:23

this is a little bit lighter gray suit

so it's good to have a charcoal gray

01:27

suit

and some kind of a medium gray suit that

you can wear looks a little bit nicer in

01:31

the summer and then the spring and the

early fall

you can always use different buttons um

i just left the brown buttons here but

you could go to a charcoal button

and like a black thread if you wanted to

a blue plaid suit you can see it's got a

window pane in here

and here's kind of a little bit picture
